WHEREAS: Minnesota's forest resources were an impetus to the original settlement and growth of the state; and

WHEREAS: Forest resources and derivative industries are a significant component of Minnesota's economy today; and

WHEREAS: Professional foresters are important in all aspects of the development, utilization and management of Minnesota's forest resources; and

WHEREAS: The University of Minnesota's Forestry Club annually pays tribute to the forestry profession and the all-important skills it requires;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim January 26-27 to be

FORESTERS' DAYS

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to consider the important contributions of the forestry profession to the well-being of our state.
