- WHEREAS: The Minnesota Jaycees are a non-profit organization dedicated to the betterment of all mankind; and
- WHEREAS: Multiple sclerosis is a disease which strikes without warning, disabling young adults of Jaycee age; and
- WHEREAS: Minnesota has the second highest incidence rate of multiple sclerosis in the nation; and
- WHEREAS: The Minnesota Jaycees have endorsed the Multiple Sclerosis Society as their Number One Priority Project for 1978-79; and
- WHEREAS: The Minnesota Jaycees have united to help raise funds and promote public awareness of this disease during the week of February 11 through February 17 through the Jaycees "Strike for MS" Bowling Competition;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 11 through February 17 to be

in Minnesota, and call upon our citizens to join the Jaycees to aid the multiple sclerosis cause.
