ORDER FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF FEES

Pursuant to the authority vested in me, under Minnesota Statutes, Section 27.07, I hereby find the need for establishing fees and hereby order that the following fees be set for inspection of potatoes qualifying for the 1979 Federal potato diversion program. The fees shall be effective on or after January 15, 1979, and will be in effect for the duration of the 1979 Federal potato diversion program. These fees are payable by participating potato growers to the Commissioner of Agriculture pursuant to law.

CHARGES:

A total of 0.6 per cwt inspected (4 1/2 cents for quality (grade) inspection plus 1 1/2 cents for certification of quantity diverted).

OVERTIME:

\$6.50 per hour, additional for inspections made on weekdays (Monday through Friday) before 8:00 a.m. and after 5:00 p.m., anytime Saturday, Sunday, and holidays.

MILEAGE:

16¢ per mile.

PAYMENTS:

Shall be made to inspector at time of inspection, or the diverter (grower) may request ASCS to pay total fee to inspection service from his diversion payment.
