ORDINANCE NO. 3-B

An Ordinance Entitled "An Ordinance Pursuant to the Petition for Annexation of Certain Properties to the City of Cook, Legally Described as Follows: All of the Southwest Quarter of Southeast Quarter (SW¹/₄ of SE¹/₄), and portions of the Southeast Quarter of Southwest Quarter (SE¹/₄ of SW¹/₄), Northeast Quarter of Southeast Quarter (NE¹/₄ of SE¹/₄), Northwest Quarter of Southeast Quarter (NW¹/₄ of SE¹/₄) and Southeast Quarter of Southeast Quarter (SE¹/₄ of SE¹/₄), all in Section Eighteen (18), Range Eighteen (18), Township Sixty-two (62), St. Louis County, Minnesota, more fully outlined in a Map submitted by Petitioners and available at the City Hall".

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Cook has been petitioned by 90% of the land owners within the above described property to have said property annexed to the City of Cook, and

WHEREAS, the land to be annexed is less than 200 acres and is 60% or more bordered by land already within the municipality, and

WHEREAS, the approximate number of residents in said area is 36, and

WHEREAS, the territory proposed for annexation is new, or is about to become, urban or suburban in character, and

WHEREAS, municipal government is required to protect the public health, safety, and welfare in reference to plat control, land development and construction of the land proposed for annexation, and the City of Cook is able to provide such municipal government, and

WHEREAS, the monetary value of the benefits conferred upon the area proposed for annexation bears a reasonable relation to the potential increase in revenues to the City of Cook, and

WHEREAS, annexation will serve to meet the City of Cook's goals as to economic, human and social development.

THEREFORE, pursuant to M.S.A. 41A.035 subd. 5, the City Council of the City of Cook does hereby ordain as follows:

That the above described property shall be annexed to the City of Cook and become part of the City of Cook.

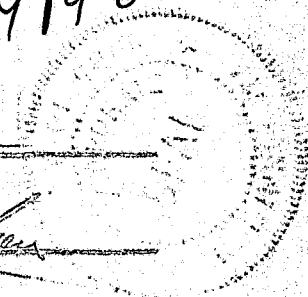

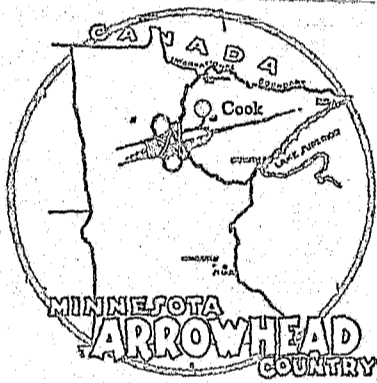


