Proclamation

WHEREAS: Eighty-eight members of the Norwegian Home Guard are now training at Minnesota's state National Guard Training Site, Camp Ripley; and

WHEREAS: A similar number of American National Guard members, including many Minnesotans, are now training at Camp Torpo, Norway; and

WHEREAS: This continuing annual exchange program serves to emphasize the bonds that have joined our two nations together; and

WHEREAS: The ancestral ties of Minnesota, more so than any state in our nation, are closely aligned with the culture, art and heritage of Norway;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby declare the month of February, 1979, to be
