WHEREAS: The contributions made by those concerned with Quality Assurance have stimulated similar motivation among other citizens in whatever vocation they may be engaged; and

WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota wishes to further promote the ideals of Quality Assurance as applied to all products for all consumers everywhere;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of March 4 through March 10, 1979, to be
