WHEREAS: More than 10,000 residents of this state are active members of the Minnesota Army and Air National Guard; and

WHEREAS: These Minnesota citizen-soldiers have served their communities state and nation in an exemplary manner whenever called upon; and

WHEREAS: The men and women of the Minnesota National Guard, as well as all National Guardsmen and Guardswomen, have demonstrated their dedication to the defense of our communities, state and nation during times of disaster and conflict; and

WHEREAS: These men and women now stand ready to serve their fellow citizens in the true spirit of the Minutemen of Revolutionary War days and the Minnesota Militia of Territorial days; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of March, 1979, to be

MINUTEMAN DAYS

in Minnesota, in honor of the selfless service of the Minnesota Army and Air National Guard.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-eighth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred seventy-nine, and of the State the one hundred twenty-first.
