WHEREAS: Friends of free enterprise at home and abroad recognize that economic freedom is essential to political freedom and personal liberty; and

WHEREAS: Free enterprise has been a major factor in the progress of our great nation and in the prosperity of its citizens; and

WHEREAS: Free enterprise has been acknowledged by peoples throughout the world as the economic system which creates material wealth and abundance, while safeguarding the principle of individual freedom; and

WHEREAS: Economic freedom requires an informed public, committed to the principles which undergird the free enterprise system;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of March 11 through March 17, 1979, to be

FREE ENTERPRISE WEEK

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to observe this week in an appropriate fashion.
