WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota has been blessed with an abundance of resources and natural beauty; and

WHEREAS: Each citizen has a responsibility to take positive measures to assure a clean, healthy environment for everyone; and

WHEREAS: For the last nine years, millions of concerned Americans have participated in Keep America Beautiful Day, working to restore beachfronts, establish arboretums, plant trees and other green, living things, and to prevent littering; and

WHEREAS: Keep America Beautiful, Incorporated, is a nonprofit, public service organization working to stimulate individual involvement in environmental improvement, on Keep America Beautiful Day and with ongoing community programs; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 28, 1979, to be
