REAS: Title I of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act provides public and private school children with additional instructional materials and personnel to assist those students performing below grade level in reading and math and

REAS: The effectiveness of Title I programs is enhanced by parental involvement and public understanding of Title I objectives and methods; and
