
ORDER PROVIDING ADDITIONAL PROTECTION FOR RUFFED GROUSE
OR PARTRIDGE.


Whereas, the Game and Fish Commissioner of Minnesota has investigated the necessity of providing additional protection for ruffed grouse or partridge and has found that this species is in danger of undue depletion,

Therefore, I, J.A.O. Preus, Governor of the State of Minnesota, pursuant to authority vested in me by Section 134 of Chapter 400, Session Laws of Minnesota, for the year 1919, do hereby order that no ruffed grouse or partridge be taken or killed in this state except from October 15th to 31st inclusive during the year 1924.

This order shall remain in force until the close of the 1925 regular session of the Legislature of the State of Minnesota, unless sooner revoked or modified.
