



Proclamation

WHEREAS: The Service Corps of Retired Executives (SCORE) and the Active Corps of Executives (ACE) are composed of persons from every type of industry who have successfully operated their own firms, and who share the goal of preserving and strengthening our free enterprise system; and

WHEREAS: SCORE and ACE members, all volunteers, provide free and confidential assistance in all aspects of management, offering their considerable experience, wisdom, and proven ability to help solve the problems encountered by small businesses throughout Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: Hundreds of businesses in our state have need at some time for the type of specialized, objective management assistance that SCORE and ACE members can provide; and

WHEREAS: SCORE and ACE are affiliated with and sponsored by the Small Business Administration, and have chapters in Rochester, Mankato, Minneapolis, Duluth, and Saint Paul, with satellite desk operations in many other communities;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Tuesday, May 1, 1979, to be
