EREAS: The American Youth Hostels organization carries on a year-round program to promote interest among all people of every race and religion in wholesome, outdoor recreation and travel, and provides simple, inexpensive, overnight hostel accommodations in our scenic, historic and cultural areas, with trained leadership and supervision; and

EREAS: The Hostel movement aids in developing more physically fit and knowledgeable young men and women, and teaches our citizens to respect people of different backgrounds and points of view; and

EREAS: Many elements of our state are members and give support to the American Youth Hostels, which make their services and facilities available for use by all citizens and organizations in Minnesota;

AND, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 6 through May 12, 1979, to be
