WHEREAS: The United Nations has declared 1979 to be International Year of the Child, and many Minnesota organizations and individuals are sponsoring and participating in activities that will enrich the lives of our children; and

WHEREAS: Important among these activities are those which will enhance the physical well-being of our children; and

WHEREAS: Accidents are the leading cause of deaths for all children after the first month of life, occurring in the automobile, the recreational area, the neighborhood, and the home; and

WHEREAS: Most accidents can be prevented and deaths and injuries greatly reduced through parental vigilance and added protective measures;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of June, 1979, to be
