WHEREAS: Highway fatalities can be averted by basic safety practices and driver consideration; and

WHEREAS: 980 Minnesotans died in traffic accidents last year; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Motor Transport Association is sponsoring two outstanding programs to better educate the public, in effect from May 25 through June 10, 1979, as part of their Highway Safety Program; and

WHEREAS: The "Take a Break for Safety" program will provide safe driving tips to motorists from noon until 6:00 p.m. on May 26 of Memorial Day weekend at two locations; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Motor Transport Association's 1979 State Truck Rodeo will offer our state's outstanding professional truck drivers an opportunity to demonstrate their safe driving skills on June 9-10 in Blaine;
