- WHEREAS: Recreational boating is a popular and enjoyable pastime in Minnesota and throughout the nation; and
- WHEREAS: It is in the best interest of every boater to command all possible knowledge of boating safety; and
- WHEREAS: The safe use of Minnesota's abundant water resources by boaters and others has long been an important goal of the State and many private agencies; and
- WHEREAS: Boating safety courses and information are readily available to all citizens through such organizations as the United States Coast Guard Auxiliary, United States Power Squadrons, the American Red Cross and various State agencies;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of June 3 through June 10, 1979, to be
