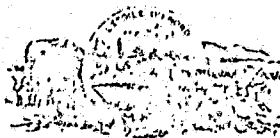

Entitled an Ordinance extending the corporate limits of the City of Barnesville to include certain unincorporated property owned by and abutting upon the limits of the City.

WHEREAS, the territory described below is not presently within the corporate limits of any incorporated city, village or borough; and,

WHEREAS, this territory abuts upon the corporate limits of the City of Barnesville at the Easterly boundary thereof and is deemed to be urban in character; and,

WHEREAS, this territory is owned in fee by the City;

The City Council of the City of Barnesville does hereby ordain as follows:

Section I; Territory Annexed: The City limits of the City of Barnesville are hereby extended to include the unplatted property described as follows, now owned by the City:

That part of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ -NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-nine (29), Township One Hundred Thirty-seven (137), Range Forty-five West (45W) described as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the South Right-of-Way line of Minnesota State Highway #34 and the East line of said Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ -NW $\frac{1}{4}$) which is the point of beginning; thence South along the East line of said Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ -NW $\frac{1}{4}$) a distance of 460 feet; thence West parallel to the South Right-of-Way line of said Highway #34 a distance of 460 feet; thence North parallel to the East line of said Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ -NW $\frac{1}{4}$) a distance of 460 feet; thence Easterly along the said South Right-of-Way line of said Highway #34 a distance of 460 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning, containing 4.85 acres, more or less, and

That part of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ -NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-nine (29), Township One Hundred Thirty-seven (137), Range Forty-five West (45W) described as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the South Right of Way Line of Minnesota State Highway #34 and the East line of said Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ -NW $\frac{1}{4}$) thence South Along said East line of said Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ -NW $\frac{1}{4}$) a distance of 460 feet; thence West parallel to the South Right of Way line of said Highway #34 a distance of 460 feet; thence North parallel to the East line of said Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ -NW $\frac{1}{4}$) a distance of 460 feet more or less to the point of intersection with the South Right of Way line of said State Highway #34, which point is the point of beginning of the tract of land herein conveyed; thence South parallel the the East line of said Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ -NW $\frac{1}{4}$) a distance of 460 feet; thence South 89°59'55" West a distance of 549.85 feet; thence North 01°02' West a distance of 460.60 feet, more or less, to a point of intersection with the South Right of Way Line of said Highway #34; thence East along said South Right of Way Line of said Highway #34 a distance of 549.19 feet, more or less to the Point of Beginning of the tract herein conveyed, containing 5.81 acres more or less, and the following described tract:

Commencing at the Northeast corner of Outlot F-30 in the City of Barnesville, Clay County Minnesota; thence proceed North at a 90 degree angle, 300 ft; thence proceed East parallel to the North line of Outlot F-30 a distance of 62.5 feet to the East line of the Township Road to the Point of Beginning of the tract of land described herein; thence proceed East 300 feet; thence proceed North 466 feet; thence proceed West


25 feet; thence proceed South 400 feet; thence proceed West 275 feet; thence proceed South 66 feet to the Point of Beginning.

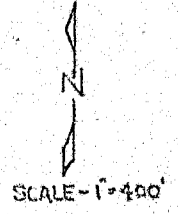

Commencing at the Northeast corner of Outlot F-30 in the City of Barnesville, Clay County, Minnesota; thence proceed North at a 90 degree angle, 300 feet; thence proceed East parallel to the North line of Outlot F-30 a distance of 62.5 feet to the East line of the Township Road to the Point of Beginning of the tract of land described herein; thence proceed East 300 feet; thence proceed North 466 feet; thence proceed West 25 feet; thence proceed South 400 feet; thence proceed West 275 feet; thence proceed South 68 feet to the Point of Beginning.

PUBLISHER'S AFFIDAVIT OF PUBLICATION

(Section 331.06 Minnesota Statutes 1961, as amended by Law of 1963)

Eugene A. Prim, being duly sworn, on oath says he is and during all the times herein stated has been the publisher of the newspaper known as The Barnesville Record-Review and has full knowledge of the facts herein stated as follows: (1) Said newspaper is printed in the English language in newspaper format and in column and sheet form equivalent in printed space to at least 900 square inches. (2) Said newspaper is a weekly and is distributed at least once each week. (3) Said newspaper has 50 percent of its news columns devoted to news of local interest to the community which it purports to serve and does not wholly duplicate any other publication and is not made up entirely of patents, plate matter and advertisements. (4) Said newspaper is circulated in and near the municipality which it purports to serve, has at least 500 copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, has an average of at least 75 percent of its total circulation currently paid or no more than three months in arrears and has entry as second-class matter in its local post-office. (5) Said newspaper purports to serve the City of Barnesville in the County of Clay and it has its known office of issue in the City of Barnesville in said county, established and open during its regular business hours for the gathering of news, sale of advertisements and sale of subscriptions and maintained by the managing officer of said newspaper or persons in his employ and subject to his direction and control during all such regular business hours and devoted exclusively during such regular business hours to the business the newspaper and business related thereto. (6) Said newspaper files a copy of each issue immediately with the State Historical Society. (7) Said newspaper is made available at single or subscription prices to any person, corporation, partnership or other unincorporated association requesting the newspaper and making the applicable payment. (8) Said newspaper has complied with all the foregoing conditions for at least one year preceding the day or dates of publication mentioned below. (9) Said newspaper has filed with the Secretary of State of Minnesota prior to January 1, 1966 and each January 1 thereafter an affidavit in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State and signed by the managing officer of said newspaper and sworn to before a notary public stating that the newspaper is a legal newspaper.

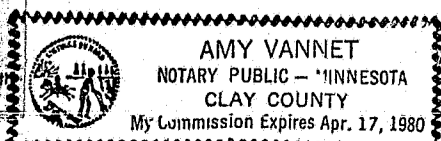


