RESOLUTION SETTING SPECIAL ELECTION

BE IT RESOLVED that the following question be submitted to the voters of the City of Montevideo at a special election to be held in the City of Montevideo on May 22, 1979:

"Should an ordinance proposed by an initiative petition be adopted which ordinance bans the use of parking meters in the City of Montevideo and provides that the cost of removing the existing meters together with the loss of revenue therefrom be born by the City of Montevideo as a part of its general operating budget?"

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a special election is hereby called for May 22, 1979, for a vote upon the foregoing question, the hours for voting shall be from 12:00 noon until 9:00 p.m.
