- REAS: Half of all bicycle / auto accidents involve children between five and fifteen years of age; and
- REAS: Three out of four bicycle / auto accidents are the fault of the cyclist; and
- REAS: Minnesota is a national leader in programs that enhance the safety of bicyclists and promote courteous, rational rider practices;
