- AS: The medical profession views breastfeeding as a concept meriting study, and the Nutrition Committee of the American Academy of Pediatrics has indicated great interest in the benefits of breastfeeding; and
- AS: There is a continuing rise in the proportion of breastfed babies in Minnesota; and
- AS: The La Leche League's Seventh International Conference will be held in Atlanta On July 7, 8, and 9;
