WHEREAS: Soccer is a fast-paced, exciting sport for both spectators and players, enjoyed by Minnesotans of all ages; and

WHEREAS: Soccer is a particularly rewarding and healthful activity for young people, who benefit from the exercise and exposure to the ideals of teamwork and good sportsmanship; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Junior Soccer Association is composed of more than 5000 young people who participate in organized league play; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Junior Soccer Association and the Minnesota Kicks professional soccer club, both affiliated with the United States Soccer Federation, are co-sponsoring activities that will draw the attention of greater numbers of Minnesotans to this fast-growing sport; and

WHEREAS: Preliminary and halftime activities at the Minnesota Kicks - Vancouver game on June 10 will feature members of the Minnesota Junior Soccer Association in a soccer ball juggling contest and exhibition; and

I, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim June 10, 1979, to be

Minnesota, and urge all citizens to demonstrate their support for youth soccer.
