ORDER FOR DISMISSAL

WHEREAS, a petition was filed for annexation of certain lands to the City of Owatonna on March 2nd, 1977; and

WHEREAS, an objection to that annexation was received by the Minnesota Municipal Board on April 15, 1977; and

WHEREAS, a hearing before the Minnesota Municipal Board was held on June 13, 1977 in the City of Owatonna; and

WHEREAS, the Petitioner, John C. Pegg, has sold his interest in the property under consideration to Mills Properties, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, there are presently discussions taking place between the City of Owatonna and the Township of Owatonna concerning possible orderly annexation in the area under consideration; and

WHEREAS, all parties through their respective councils, have signed a stipulation and request for dismissal of petition without prejudice;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above-entitled petition is hereby dismissed without prejudice. The property description in said petition is described as follows:

All that part of the NE $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 22, T 107 N, R 20 W, Steele County, Minnesota, described by:

Commencing at the northeast corner of said NE $\frac{1}{2}$, thence S 0° 06' 45" E, assumed bearing, 1494.95 feet along the east line of said NE $\frac{1}{2}$ to the True Point of Beginning; thence S 0° 06' 45" E 807.13 feet along the east line of said NE $\frac{1}{2}$ to the northerly right of way line of Trunk Highway No. 14 and 218; thence N 88° 20' 14" W 1459.07 feet along the northerly right of way line of said highways; thence N. 63° 37' 07" W 181.67 feet along the northerly right of way line of said highways to the easterly line of C.S.A.H. No. 6; thence N 38° 54' W 250 feet along the easterly line of said C.S.A.H. No. 6; thence N 88° 20' 14" W 43.44 feet to the centerline of said C.S.A.H. No. 6; thence N. 38° 54' W 623.28 feet along the centerline of said C.S.A.H. No. 6; thence N 89° 55' 04" E 2211.43 feet to said True Point of Beginning;


