ORDINANCE NO. 118

THIRD SERIES

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF JACKSON TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED, UNPLATTED LAND ABUTTING UPON THE LIMITS.

WHEREAS, the following described land is owned by the City of Jackson, abuts upon the corporate limits of the City of Jackson, and is not included in any other municipality; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that annexation of said lands will be in the best interest of the City of Jackson and of the territory affected;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF JACKSON ORDAINS:

Section 1. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the City are hereby extended to include the territory described as follows, and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

A parcel of land (lying North of I-90 right of way) in the Northeast Quarter of Section Thirteen (13), Des Moines Township, Jackson County, Minnesota, described as follows: Commencing at the Northeast corner of Section Thirteen (13), Township One Hundred Two (102) North, Range Thirty-five (35), West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, thence South 0°10'30" East along the East Section line of said Section a distance of 1038.90 feet; thence South 89°13' West along the North right of way line of I-90 a distance of 2675.08 feet; thence North 0°10' West along the West Quarter line of said Northeast Quarter a distance of 1077.20 feet; thence South 89°57' East along the North Section line of said section a distance of 2676.75 feet to the point of beginning, containing 65.00 acres, more or less.

Section 2. Zoning District: The land hereby annexed to and included within the city is hereby designated as a Service Business District, "B-1".
