

ORDINANCE NO. 23

THIRD SERIES

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF JACKSON TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED, UNPLATTED LAND ABUTTING UPON THE CITY LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated the 20th day of February, 1979, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the City Council on the 20th day of February, 1979; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition is approximately 105 acres of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of any incorporated city, village, or borough; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by the owners of all of the land embraced within the area described in the petition; and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the town board, the county board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and the Town Board of Des Moines Township has filed a waiver of its right to object; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the City limits at the western boundary thereof; NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF JACKSON ORDAINS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby determines (a) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City and of the territory affected; (b) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City limits and is, or is about to become, urban or suburban in character; and (c) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village or borough.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the City are hereby extended to include the following described parts of Section 14, Township 102 North, Range 35, West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, Jackson County, Minnesota, and the

same are hereby annexed to and included within the City as effectually as if it had already been a part thereof:

All of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4 NE 1/4) and all of the South Half of the Northeast Quarter (S 1/2 NE 1/4) not already within the corporate limits of the City of Jackson, as now located and established; and also that part of the North Half of the Southeast Quarter (N 1/2 SE 1/4) lying North of the right-of-way of the Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul, and Pacific Railroad Company and not already within the corporate limits of the City of Jackson, as now located and established.

Section 3. Zoning District. The land hereby annexed to and included within the City is hereby designated as a Service Business District, "B-1".

Section 4. Filing. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, the Jackson County Auditor, the Jackson County Recorder, and the Clerk of Des Moines Township, Jackson County, Minnesota.

Section 5. Effective date. This ordinance takes effect fourteen (14) days after its publication.
