This is to inform you that your undated letter in reference to the above matter addressed to the Consul of Lithuania and Embassy of the USSR was referred to me.


Kindly take notice that Lithuania's incorporation into the USSR is not recognized by the United States Government and thus mailing notice to the Embassy of the USSR in Lithuanian estate matters is inappropriate.

Due to limited time before the scheduled hearing on June 18th, 1979, it is impossible for me to verify whether the above decedent was born in Lithuania and whether there are any surviving next of kin residing in Lithuania.

Since the name does not indicate the decedent's Lithuanian origin a photo copy of the Last Will and Testament as well as more particulars about the place of his birth would be appreciated.
