## **DELEGATION ORDER**

Providing for the Assignment of Duties to the Minnesota Department of Personnel

I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and Minnesota Statutes, Section 4.07, hereby issue this Delegation Order.

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Personnel Act (IPA) provides grants for improving State and local personnel administration, and these grants are intended for various planning, developmental, and operational efforts that may or may not involve training; and,

WHEREAS, no state agency has been otherwise designated by Taw to apply for, receive, and accept such federal funds; and,

WHEREAS, the Governor has the authority to designate a state agency to act for him in applying for, receiving, and accepting federal funds as provided by Minnesota Statutes, Section 4.07, Subdivisions 1 through 3;

NOW, THEREFORE, I order that:

The Minnesota Department of Personnel be designated as the
State agency to act for me, in applying for, receiving, accepting

and expending Intergovernmental Personnel Act (IPA) funds pursuant to Public Law 91-648.

This order shall be effective immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State and shall remain in effect until superseded, amended, or repealed by proper authority.
