

# PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS: The Twin City Society of X-ray Technicians met on March 8, 1938, to accept the Bylaws and Constitution for the American Society of Radiologic Technologists, so that all affiliated societies of radiologic technologists would be established with a uniform foundation; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Society of Radiologic Technologists, composed of the 47 members of the former Twin Cities Society of X-ray Technicians and the Arrowhead Society, was formally recognized as an affiliated society of the American Society of Radiologic Technologists on the 10th day of December, 1938; and

WHEREAS: The 3000 Registered Radiologic Technologists of the State of Minnesota have recognized the need for continued professional growth and education in the exchange of technical information in the interests of better patient care; and

WHEREAS: The dedication of these people has stood in testimony of their concern for improved patient care through radiation protection, continuing education and the need for exchange of information for forty-one years;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 30 through October 6, 1979, to be
