

WHEREAS: Motor vehicles known as Street Rods are owned in large numbers by citizens of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: Street Rods have established an exceptional safety record as a class of motor vehicles; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota citizens build and collect Street Rods for their responsible recreational use; and

WHEREAS: The State Department of Public Safety grants to Street Rod owners all rights and privileges afforded other special classes of motor vehicles;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of July 16 through July 22, 1979, to be

STREET ROD WEEK

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to cooperate in this observance in order that the well-being of our Street Rod owners and other users of our streets and highways may be safeguarded.
