WHEREAS: All citizens deserve to be informed about resource conditions and have a voice in guiding future conservation programs; and


WHEREAS: The Minnesota Congress on Soil and Water Management is encouraging citizen involvement in the State's soil and water conservation programs;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the months of August, September and October 1979 to be
