COMMISSIONER'S SCIENTIFIC AND NATURAL AREA ORDER NO. 10

WHEREAS THE LANDS IN BELTRAMI COUNTY DESCRIBED AS:
Lots Three (3) and Four (4) in Section Three (3), Township One
Hundred Forty-six (146) North, Range Thirty (30) West, contain
natural features which significantly illustrate an undisturbed
plant community and the habitat for over fourteen species of
orchids many of which are rare or unusual such as Dragon's Mouth,
Fairy Slipper, and Rose Pogonia.

AND, WHEREAS, The most effective means by which such
lands can be used and protected for educational and research
purposes in such manner, and by such means as will leave them
conserved for future generations is by designation as a Scientific
and Natural Area.

NOW, THEREFORE: I, Joseph N. Alexander, Commissioner
of the Department of Natural Resources, pursuant to authority vested
in me by law, do hereby designate the above described lands as
Pennington Orchid Bog Scientific and Natural Area. Furthermore,
Pennington Orchid Bog Scientific and Natural Area is designated
as a Public Use Unit, "limiting use to programs conducted by
qualified scientists and graduate and post graduate students,
programs for primary, secondary, and college undergraduate students,
and interpretive programs for the benefit of the general public."

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the provisions of NR 300 through
and including NR 303 shall apply to the use of the above designated
area, except that all visitors must secure a permit in advance from
the Department of Natural Resources.
