WHEREAS: Physical therapists are an important component of the health care delivery system in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: Physical therapy helps restore useful movement and physical independence to individuals whose mobility has been impaired; and

WHEREAS: Physical therapists are professionals who, after completing college degree programs lasting from four to six years, are tested and licensed by the State Board of Medical Examiners; and

WHEREAS: There are more than 1200 registered physical therapists and physical therapist assistants in Minnesota, over 600 of whom are members of the Minnesota Chapter of the American Physical Therapy Association;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 9 through September 15, 1979, to be

PHYSICAL THERAPY WEEK

in Minnesota, and encourage all citizens to become familiar with the contributions of this profession to the good health of all.
