AN ORDINANCE EXTENDENT THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF BUFFALL LAKE, MINNESOTA, at INCORPORATED UNPLATION TED LAND NOT EXCEEDING SO ACRES IN AREA ABUTING UPON THE CITY LIMITS OF TH

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated October 17, 1978, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the council on the 2nd day of November, 1978; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all of the owners of the territory hereinafter deacribed; and

WHEREAS, no objections to

the annexation have been received from the town board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the city limits at the easterly boundary thereof;

The council of the City of Buffalo Lake, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. The city council hereby determines (1) that the territory described herein abuts upon the city limits and is about to become urban or suburban in character, and (2) that none of the territory is now included within the limits of any city.

Section 2. TERRITORY AN-NEXED. The corporate limits of the city are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby anacted to said included within the city as effectually as if it has originally been a part thereof:

All the tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Renville and State of Minnesota, described as follows:

That part of the West 40 Rods which is South of the right of way of the Chicago Milwaukee-St. Paul & Pacific Ry. Co. in the Southwest Corner of the Southwest Quarter in Section 29, Township 115, Range 31, not including existing highway and railroad right of way and

railroad right-of-way, and All that tract of land lying between the following described line and the Southerly right-of-way of the Chicago-Milwaukee-St. Paul & Pacific Ry. Co.: commencing at a point on the East line of the West One-half of Section 30, Township 115 North, Range 31 West, which is 120 feet South of the Center line of the right-of-way of the Chicago-Milwaukee-St. Paul & Pacific Ry. Co.; thence Easterly and parallel with the Center line of said right-of-way for a distance of 383 feet; thence Northerly and parallel with said East line of the West One-half of said Section 30 for a distance of 50 feet; thence Easterly and parallel with the center line of said right-of-way at a distance of 70 feet South therefrom to the East line of said Section 30.

Section 3. FILING. The city clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Board, the Secretary of State, the Town Clerk, and the County Auditor.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinates takes effect upon its persage and publication and the filling of the certified copies as directed in Section 3, and approval of the ordinance by the Manusota Municipal Board.
