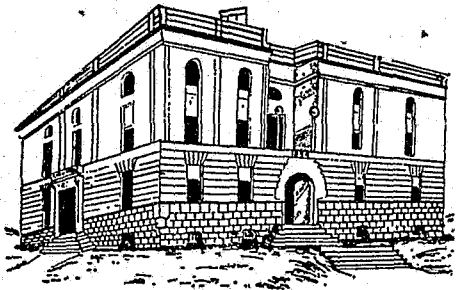

Ordinance 79- 8

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 79-1 AS IT PERTAINS TO
THE ANNEXATION OF LAND

Whereas, Ordinance 79-1 was adopted on second reading on May 8,
1979, and

Whereas, a line was omitted from Section 2 (c)

THE CITY OF FARIBAULT ORDAINS:
Section 1.

That Section 2 (c) shall read as follows:

That part of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 24, Township 110 North, Range 21 West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, Rice County, Minnesota, lying easterly from the westerly line of the Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul and Pacific Railway Company right of way, and southerly from the following described strip of land: A strip of land 100.00 feet in width, being 50.00 feet on both sides of the following described line: Beginning at a point in the East line of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 24, South 0°10'11" West (for purposes of this description bearing of said line is assumed), 33.00 feet from the Northeast corner of said Southeast Quarter of Northeast Quarter; thence North 87°04'20" West, about 640 feet to the westerly line of said Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul and Pacific Railway Company right of way, and there terminating; subject to railroad right of way.

Section 2. FILING.

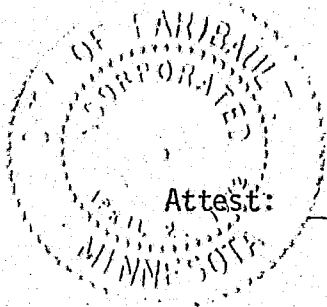
The City Administrator is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, the Rice County Auditor, and the Town Clerk of Wells Township and Cannon City Township.

Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE OF ANNEXATION.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force 30 days from and after its passage and publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 2.
