ORDINANCE NO. 477

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS TO THE CITY OF WASECA, MINNESOTA, AND ESTABLISHING THE ZONING THEREOF.

Waseen

WHEREAS, at the request of the landowner, certain lands are petitioned for annexation into the City of Waseca, and

WHEREAS, the land hereinafter described is unplatted land situated in Woodville Township, Waseca County, Minnesota, and is contiguous to the incorporated limits of the City of Waseca, and

WHEREAS Woodville Township and Waseca County have waived any claim or appeal against said annexation petition, and

WHEREAS, the land hereinafter described is now urban or suburban in character, and

WHEREAS, the Waseca City Council has determined that the annexation of said land to the City of Waseca will be in the best interest of the City of Waseca,

WHEREAS, said lands are in need of orderly annexation,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WASECA DOES ORDAIN:

Sec. 1. That there is hereby annexed to and included within the City of Waseca, Minnesota, the following described land in the County of Waseca, State of Minnesota;

Beginning at a point on the East line of Section 19, Township 107 North, Range 22 West; said point being 345 feet South of the Northeast Corner of said Section 19; thence Southeasterly 73.82 feet to a point 410 feet South of the North line of Section 20, Township 107 North, Range 22 West; thence South on a line 35 feet East of and parallel to the West line of said Section 20 for a distance of 90.36 feet; thence West on a line parallel to the North line of said Section 19, a distance of 561.42 feet to the East right-of-way line of the Chicago and Northwestern Railroad; thence North along the East rightof-way line of the Chicago and Northwestern Railroad a distance of 445.76 feet to a point 50 feet South of the North line of Section 19; thence East on a line 50 feet South of and parallel to the North line of said Section 19, a distance of 120.64 feet; thence Southeasterly for a distance of 508.83 feet to the point of beginning, containing 4.18 acres.

- Sec. 2. That the annexed land shall be zoned within the meaning of the zoning ordinances and codes of the City of Waseca as Industrial District.
- Sec. 3. That a certified copy of this Ordinance shall be filed with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, the Waseca County Auditor, the Waseca County Register of Deeds and the Clerk of the Woodville Township Board.
- Sec. 4. That this ordinance shall be effective upon passage and legal publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in Sec. 3.



PETITION FOR ANNEXATION

TO THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WASECA, MINNESOTA:

We, the undersigned, being the owners of the territory described below, hereby request the Council to annex this territory to the City of Waseca and to extend the City boundaries to include the same, and for that purpose respectfully state:

I. The territory to be annexed consists entirely of lands which are unplatted and which do not exceed two hundred acres in size. All of these lands lie entirely within the County of Waseca, Minnesota, and a description of such lands are as follows:

Beginning at a point on the East line of Section 19, Township 107 North, Range 22 West; said point being 345 feet South of the Northeast Corner of said Section 19; thence Southeasterly 73.82 feet to a point 410 feet South of the North line of Section 20, Township 107 North, Range 22 West; thence South on a line 35 feet East of and parallel to the West line of said Section 20 for a distance of 90.36 feet; thence West on a line parallel to the North line of said Section 19, a distance of 561.42 feet to the East right-of-way line of the Chicago and Northwestern Railroad; thence North along the East rightof-way line of the Chicago and Northwestern Railroad a distance of 445.76 feet to a point 50 feet South of the North line of Section 19; thence East on a line 50 feet South of and parallel to the North line of said Section 19, a distance of 120.64 feet; thence Southeasterly for a distance of 508.83 feet to the point of beginning, containing 4.18 acres.

Commencing at a point 35 feet East and 500 feet South of the Northeast Corner of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 19, Township 107 North, Range 22 West; thence West 345.57 feet; thence South 1° 26.6′ East 383.12 feet; thence South 90° 00′ West 50 feet; thence South 1° 26.6′/803.38 feet, said point being 165 feet East of the East line of the Chicago and Northwestern Railroad right-of-way; thence East to a point 35 feet East of the East line of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 19, Township 107 North, Range 22 West; thence North 1186.5 feet to the point of beginning, containing 9.35 acres, more or less

and to be zoned as INDUSTRIAL.

2. The territory described above abutts upon the city limits and none of this described premises is presently included within the corporate limits of any incorporated city, village or borough.

3. All of this territory is or is about to become urban or suburban in character.

4. And the owners of said premises are set out below with the description of their property set our opposite their name as follows, viz:.

S of and parallel to the N line of said Sec. 19, a distance of 120.64 ft; thence Satheasterly for a distance of 508.83 ft. to the point of beginning, containing 4.18 acres.


