STATUTES CHAPTER 490.


WHEREAS, the Honorable C. Luther Eckman, Judge of the Sixth Judicial District, has submitted to the undersigned Governor of the State of Minnesota a letter, dated July 2, 1979, applying for retirement from his position as District Judge, effective August 1, 1979, pursuant to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes Section 490.126; and

WHEREAS, the said C. Luther Eckman has served as a District Judge of said District Court for the past thirteen (13) years; and

WHEREAS, the said C. Luther Eckman has satisfied the necessary legal requirements established under Minnesota Statutes Chapter 490 for such retirement at the close of business on July 31, 1979.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, Governor of the State of Minnesota, acting pursuant to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes Chapter 490, do hereby order and direct the retirement of the Honorable C. Luther Eckman, Judge of the District Court for the Sixth Judicial District, State of Minnesota, to become effective at the close of business on July 31, 1979. He shall become entitled thereafter to retirement compensation as provided under the provisions of Minnesota Statutes Chapter 490. I hereby direct that this Order be filed in the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.


