OF MINNESOTA STATUTES CHAPTER 490.


WHEREAS, the Honorable Edward H. Luedloff, Judge of the County Court in and for the County of Carver, State of Minnesota, has submitted his written application for retirement, by letter dated December 15, 1978, requesting that said retirement be made effective as of February 28, 1979; and

WHEREAS, the said Edward H. Luedloff has served as County Court Judge in and for the County of Carver for the past twenty-four (24) years; and

WHEREAS, the said Edward H. Luedloff has satisfied the necessary legal requirements established under Minnesota Statutes Sections 490.121 to 490.132 for such retirement at the close of business on February 28, 1979.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, Governor of the State of Minnesota, acting in accordance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes Chapter 490, do hereby order and direct the retirement of the Honorable Edward H. Luedloff, Judge of the County Court, County of Carver, State of Minnesota, said retirement to be deemed to have become effective at the close of business on February 28, 1979. He shall become entitled thereafter to such retirement compensation as provided under the provisions of Minnesota Statutes Chapter 490. I hereby direct that this Order be filed in the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.
