NOW, THEREFORE, WE, Albert H. Quie and Lou Wangberg, Governor and Lieutenant Governor, of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October 24, 1979, to be

DIGNITY OF MANKIND DAY

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to be supportive of their fellow man and sensitive to their needs and let us invite all nations of the world to share with us in mankind's recognition of its dignity.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we have hereunto set our hands and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this eighteenth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred seventy-nine and of the State the one hundred twenty-second.
