WHEREAS: Members of the Minnesota Association of Legal Secretaries adhere to a strict Code of Ethics, maintaining the highest standards in their contacts with government, courts, law offices, clients, and all persons; and

WHEREAS: The efficiency of the professional services of legal secretaries is of first importance to government, the courts, and to attorneys and their clients; and

WHEREAS: One of the aims and purposes of the Minnesota Association of Legal Secretaries is to further the education of its members and to increase their knowledge of the law; and

WHEREAS: It is in the public interest that legal secretaries have the opportunity to observe the government with which they are so closely associated by reason of their profession as legal secretaries;

NOW, THEREFORE, WE, Albert H. Quie and Lou Wangberg, Governor and Lieutenant Governor, of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of October 7 through 13, 1979, to be
