Ladies and Gentlemen:





An Ordinance extending the corporate limits of the City of Chisago City, Minnesota.

WHEREAS the territory described below is not presently within the corporate limits of any incorporated, city village or borough, and,

WHEREAS the sole owner of the property described below petitioned the City Council of the City of Chisago City, Minnesota on the 5th day of March, 1979, to annex the same to the City of Chisago City, and,

WHEREAS, by resolution adopted by the City Council on June 26, 1979, and served upon the Chisago County Board of Commissioners, the Chisago Lakes Township Board and the Minnesota Municipal Commission by mailing a copy of same to each of them on the 20th day of March, 1979, the said City Council expressed its intention to annex the territory described below to said City, and,

WHEREAS no objections have been received from any party as to the proposed annexation.

NOW THEREFORE the City Council of the City of Chisago City, Chisago County, Minnesota, ordains as follows:

Section 1. The corporate limits of the City of Chisago City are hereby extended to include the property legally described as follows:

In Chisago Villas:

Lots 43,45,46 and 47

Lots 48,49,50 and 51, the following portion:

From northeast corner of Lot 48, west on north line 403 feet; then south 3 1/2° west 957 feet to 6 feet north of south line of Lot 51; then east parallel to south line 251 1/2 feet, to north line of Madison Street; then northeast on north line of Madison Street to west line of Arnold Avenue; then northwest along said line of beginning.

In Chisago Lake Township:

Block 42;

Lot 6 except south 12 feet

Lots 7,8,9, and 10

Lot 11 except south 12 feet of easterly 20 feet

Lots 12 and 13 except easterly 20 feet

Lots 14,15 and 16, the westerly 120 feet

Block 51:

James Hoy, being duly sworn, on oath says he is and during all times herein stated has been the publisher and printer of the newspaper known as the Chisago County Press and has full knowledge of the facts herein stated as follows: 1) Said newspaper is printed in the English language in newspaper format and in column and sheet form equivalent in printed space to at least 900 square inches. 2) Said newspaper is a weekly and is distributed at least once each week. 3) Said newspaper has 50% of its news columns devoted to news of local interest to the community which it purports to serve and does not wholly duplicate any other publication and is not made up entirely of patents, plate matter and advertisements. 4) Said newspaper is circulated in and near the municipality which it purports to serve, has at least 500 copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, has an average of at least 75% of its total circulation currently paid or no more than three months in arrears and has entry as second class matter in its local post office. 5) Said newspaper purports to serve the Village of Lindstrom in the county of Chisago and has its known office of issue in the Village of Lindstrom in said county, Minnesota, during its regular business hours for the gathering of news, sale of advertisements and sale of subscriptions and maintained by the publisher of said newspaper or persons in his employ and subject to his direction and control during all such regular business hours and devoted exclusively during such regular business hours to the business of the newspaper and business related thereto. 6) Said newspaper files a copy of each issue immediately with the State Historical Society. 7) Said newspaper has complied with all the foregoing conditions for at least one year preceding the day or dates of publication listed below. 8) Said newspaper has filed with the secretary of state prior to January 1, 1966 and each January 1 thereafter an affidavit in the form prescribed by the secretary of state and signed by the publisher of said newspaper and sworn to before a notary public stating that the newspaper is a legal newspaper. 9) Said newspaper was on May 20, 1965 qualified as a medium of official and legal publication and has continually thereafter met the foregoing conditions.
