COMMISSIONER'S STATE RECREATIONAL TRAIL
ORDER NO. 6 (SAKATA SINGING HILLS)
AMENDING, IN PART, ORDER NO. 2

WHEREAS, that portion of the Sakata Singing Hills recreational trail from its westerly terminus near the Lime Valley Road in an easterly direction to its intersection with Blue Earth County Highway No. 12, all located within the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) of Section 32, all of Section 33, and the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4 SW 1/4) of Section 34, all in Township 109 North, Range 26 West, is located in a well populated residential area in the immediate vicinity of the City of Mankato;

WHEREAS, hunting in the above described residential area causes a potential hazard of personal injury and property damage to the residents of the area; and

WHEREAS, the use of trails for hunting purposes under these circumstances is inconsistent with the activities carried on in the vicinity of the trail; and

WHEREAS, the potential hazard created outweighs, in this instance, the public interest in having such recreational trail area open to hunting;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOSEPH N. ALEXANDER, Commissioner of the Department of Natural Resources, pursuant to authority vested in me under Minnesota Regulations NR 20 (1) and other lawful authority do hereby designate the above described trail area as a no hunting zone to better serve the public interest.


