WHEREAS: From time immemorial, all mankind has declared peace among nations to be the ultimate goal of every society; and

WHEREAS: Human beings must live and work for peace, moreso than fight and die for it, so that peace as a path for the future becomes a reality; and

WHEREAS: The world is now a small community in terms of mutual dependency and communications between peoples, states and cities of the world in actions leading to peace or war; and

WHEREAS: The Worldwide Peace Day Foundation, through programs and activities involving schools, community groups and educators, having originated in this nation's capitol, offers a service for unity in human problem solving under threat of universal disaster;

NOW, THEREFORE, WE, Albert H. Quie and Lou Wangberg, Governor and Lieutenant Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim November 1, 1979 to be

WORLDWIDE PEACE DAY

in Minnesota, and encourage the citizens of this state to join in this effort toward building a more peaceful world.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we have hereunto set our hands and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this eighth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred seventy-nine, and of the State the one hundred twenty-second.
