WHEREAS: Surgery today is a highly technical, sophisticated, and exacting procedure; and

WHEREAS: The registered nurse in the operating room is a highly skilled expert in providing nursing care and managing the operating room environment; and

WHEREAS: The registered nurse is an expert in alleviating a patient's fears, preparing him for what will happen during surgery and how he will feel afterward, and understanding him as a total person; and

WHEREAS: The registered nurse acts as the patient's advocate during surgery;

NOW, THEREFORE, WE, Albert H. Quie and Lou Wangberg, Governor and Lieutenant Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim November 14, 1979, as

## OPERATING ROOM NURSE DAY

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to recognize the nation's registered nurses who practice in the operating rooms.
