WHEREAS: Minnesota is the very heartland of the winter recreation area in this country; and its reputation for being a "winter wonderland" offering many recreational activities is nationwide; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota eagerly accepts the responsibility to keep people interested and involved in winter recreational activities because their awareness and participation in winter activities play a vital part in our tourism economy; and

WHEREAS: Winter recreational activities promote not only statewide well-being in encouraging citizens to stay in the state because of readily accessible recreational activities, which minimizes unnecessary energy use for travel; but also personal well-being in encouraging good health, and family and community activity; and

WHEREAS: Citizens regard outdoor winter activities as a way of life in Minnesota, and millions are avid participants in Minnesota winter recreational activities such as downhill and cross country skiing, snowmobiling, skating, and ice fishing;

NOW, THEREFORE, WE, Albert H. Quie and Lou Wangberg, Governor and Lieutenant Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of December 9 through 16, 1979, as

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to participate in winter activities.
