



PRINTER'S AFFIDAVIT OF PUBLICATION

Donager**....., being duly sworn, on oath says he is and during all the times herein stated has been the publisher and printer of the newspaper known as The Littlefork Times and has full knowledge of the facts herein stated as follows: (1) Said newspaper is printed in English language in newspaper format and in column and sheet form equivalent in printed space to at least 900 square inches. (2) Said newspaper is a weekly and is distributed at least once each week. (3) Said newspaper has 50% of its news columns devoted to news of local interest to the community which it purports to serve and does not wholly duplicate any other publication and is not made up entirely of patents, plate matter and advertisements. (4) Said newspaper is circulated in and near the municipality which it purports to serve, has at least 500 copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, has an average of at least 75% of its total circulation currently paid or no more than three months in arrears and has entry as second-class matter in its local post-office. (5) Said newspaper purports to serve the City of Littlefork in the County of Koochiching and it has its known office of issue in the City of Littlefork in said county, established and open during its regular business hours for the gathering of news, sale of advertisements and sale of subscriptions and maintained by the Publisher of said newspaper or persons in his employ and subject to his direction and control during all such regular business hours and devoted exclusively during such regular business hours to the business of the newspaper and business related thereto. (6) Said newspaper files a copy of each issue immediately with the State Historical Society. (7) Said newspaper is made available at single or subscription prices to any person, corporation, partnership or other unincorporated association requesting the newspaper and making the applicable payment. (8) Said newspaper has complied with all the foregoing conditions for at least one year preceding the day or dates of publication mentioned below. (9) Said newspaper has filed with the Secretary of State of Minnesota prior to January 1, 1966 and each January 1 thereafter an affidavit in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State and signed by the publisher of said newspaper and sworn to before a notary public stating that the newspaper is a legal newspaper.

WHEREAS, Said property is unincorporated and abuts the City of Littlefork and is unorganized without any town boards; and

WHEREAS, Said property now or is about to become urban or suburban in character; and

WHEREAS, There are One Hundred percent (100%) of the owners of said property who have petitioned for the annexation of said property.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Littlefork that the following described property is hereby annexed:

Lots Two (2), Three (3), Five (5), and the South Five Hundred Fifteen Feet (So. 515') of Lot Seven (7), All in Auditor's Plat Nine (9).

ORDINANCE 82

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MADISON LAKE TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED PLATTED AND UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA ABUTTING UPON THE CITY LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated February 5, 1979, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the council on the Fifth day of February, 1979; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all owners; and

WHEREAS, a waiver of objection to the annexation has been received from the Jamestown Board dated March 13, 1979, and from the Blue Earth County Board dated February 16, 1979; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the city limits at the western boundary thereof;

The council of the City of Madison Lake, Minnesota ordains:

Section 231:01: The city council hereby determines (1) that the territory described herein abuts upon the city limits and is about to become urban or suburban in character; and (2) that none of the territory is now included within the limits of any city.


Section 231:02: Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the city are hereby extended to include the platted and unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the city as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

South East Quarter of the South West Quarter
of Section Thirty Four, Township One Hundred
Nine, Range Twenty Five.

Section 231:03: Filing. The city clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Board, the Secretary of State, the Town Clerk, and the County Auditor.

Section 231:04: Effective Date. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 3, and approval of the ordinance by the Minnesota Municipal Board.
