PETITION FOR ANNEXATION
TO THE
CITY OF PAYNESVILLE

TO THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYNESVILLE, MINNESOTA: :

We, the undersigned, being all the owners of the territory described below, hereby request the Council to annex this territory to the City and to extend the City boundaries to include the same, and for that purpose respectfully state:

1. The territory to be annexed consists of the following described property all being within the County of Stearns, State of Minnesota:

That part of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SE 1/4 NE 1/4) of Section 16, Township 122 North, Range 32 West, Stearns County, Minnesota, described as follows: Beginning at a point on the West line of said SE 1/4 NE 1/4, said point being the Northeast corner of Meyer's Morningside Manor, according to the plat on file and of record, thence Southerly, along said West line, to the Southwest corner of said SE 1/4 NE 1/4; thence Easterly, along the South line of said SE 1/4 NE 1/4, to a point of intersection with a line parallel to the west line of said SE 1/4 NE 1/4 and 160 feet Easterly of said West line; thence Northerly, along said parallel line, to a point; thence deflect 85 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds and in a Northwesterly direction to the point of beginning and there terminating.

2. The territory described above abuts upon the City limits on the Eastern boundary thereof and none of it is presently included within the corporate limits of any incorporated City, Village or Borough.

3. All of this territory is or is about to become residential in character, the undersigned intending to put upon said premises residential homes and plat a subdivision into lots for sale.

That public utilities are necessary for this development and that there is immediately adjacent to and available to the property water service and that sanitary sewer mains could be made available to the same, and that the Petition is made in reliance upon the City having indicated that they are willing to extend the necessary utilities to said property.

ORDINANCE NO. 4 - 1979

ORDINANCE TO ANNEX CERTAIN PROPERTY ADJOINING
THE CITY OF PAYNESVILLE

WHEREAS, certain territory described below is not presently included within the corporate limits of any incorporated city, village or borough; and

WHEREAS, this territory borders upon the city limits of the City of Paynesville and is deemed to be residential in character; and,

WHEREAS, the property has access to city water and sewer and has been developed to some degree and is in a position for further development.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Paynesville ordains:

Section 1. TERRITORY ANNEXED. The corporate limits of the City of Paynesville, Minnesota, are hereby extended to include the unplatted territory described as follows, which territory is now and has heretofore been adjacent to the incorporated limits of the City of Paynesville:

That part of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SE 1/4 NE 1/4) of Section 16, Township 122 North, Range 32 West, Stearns County, Minnesota, described as follows: Beginning at a point on the West line of said SE 1/4 NE 1/4, said point being the Northeast corner of Meyer's Morningside Manor, according to the plat on file and of record; thence Southerly, along said West line, to the southwest corner of said SE 1/4 NE 1/4; thence Easterly, along the South line of said SE 1/4 NE 1/4, to a point of intersection with a line parallel to the West line of said SE 1/4 NE 1/4 and 160 feet Easterly of said West line; thence Northerly, along said parallel line, to a point; thence deflect 85 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds and in a northwesterly direction to the point of beginning and there terminating.

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description and bounded as described is approximately 2.57 acres more or less.

Section 3. FILING. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Secretary of State, the County
