A copy of each affidavit is filed with the State Historical Society, St. Paul.

ORDINANCE NO. 1976-3

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ALBERTVILLE, MINNESOTA TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED UNPLATTED LANDS NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA ADJACENT UPON THE CITY LIMITS OF ALBERTVILLE.

WHEREAS, a certain Petition dated July 17, 1976, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the council on the 17th day of July, 1976; and

WHEREAS, the Petition was signed by all owners of said territory; and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received by the council from the Town Board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the Petition abuts the city limits of the easterly boundaries thereof;

The council of the City of Albertville, Minnesota ordains:

Section 1. The city council hereby determines: (1) that the territory described herein abuts upon the city limits and is urban or suburban in character; and (2) that none of the territory is now included within the limits of any city.

Section 2. The corporate limits of the city are hereby extended to include the unplatied land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the city of Albertville, and if said originally been a part thereof, the Exhibit A attached hereto.

Section 3. The city clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Board, the Secretary of State, the Franklin Town Clerk, and the Wright County Auditor.

Section 4. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 3, and approval of the ordinance by the Minnesota Municipal Board.
