- WHEREAS: Community Education is a concept that stresses an expanded role for public education and provides a dynamic approach to individual and community improvement; and
- WHEREAS: Community Education encourages the development of a comprehensive and coordinated delivery system for providing educational, recreational, social and cultural services for all people in a community; and
- WHEREAS: SINCE THAT GATHERING COMMUNITY EDUCATION HAS COME TO OPERATE IN MORE THAN 300 MINNESOTA SCHOOL DISTRICTS, AND OUR STATE HAS RISEN TO A POSITION OF NATIONAL LEADERSHIP IN THIS FIELD OF ENDEAVOR; AND
- WHEREAS: IN 1979, AT THE TENTH ANNIVERSARY OF THAT IMPORTANT CONFERENCE, THE IDEA THAT OUR SCHOOLS SHOULD SERVE EVERYONE IN THE COMMUNITY, FROM PRE-SCHOOLERS THROUGH SENIOR CITIZENS, IS CONTINUING TO EXPAND IN OUR STATE, AND HAS A PROMISING FUTURE;
