ORDER TO ESTABLISH FEES

Pursuant to the authority vested in me, under Minnesota Statutes, Section 16A.128, 17B.15, and 17B.25, I hereby find the need for establishing fees and hereby order that the following fees be set. The fees shall be effective on or after January 1, 1980. These fees are payable by the parties requesting Grain Inspection services to the Commissioner of Agriculture pursuant to law.

When a sanitation certificate is required for the examination of one or more ships' holds, tanks or compartments to determine if it is substantially clean, dry, and free of insects injurious to stored grain and ready to receive grain, the following fees will apply:

<u>VESSELS</u> (Not Tankers)	Docked at various piers \$40.00 At anchor in streamLaunch to be furnished by ships' agents or party
	ordering examination
	re-examined
TANKERS	Docked at various piers \$50.00 At anchor in streamLaunch to be furnished by ships' agents or party
	ordering examination
	Minimum charge for any re-examination . \$25.00

In addition to the above stated fee, a charge will be made for all overtime services performed. This overtime charge will be billed at the existing overtime rate and will be based on the number of hours due the Examiner according to the existing agreement in regard to the guaranteed minimum hours of pay as it pertains to services performed before and after hours, Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays.
