

Proclamation

WHEREAS: Food is an absolute necessity in building sound bodies and minds of young students; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota School Lunch Program is dedicated to providing highly nutritious meals at a reasonable cost; and

WHEREAS: Agriculture is Minnesota's number one industry and provides not only our students, but many students around this nation with one-third of their daily nutritional requirements; and

WHEREAS: It is fitting we salute our youth, our School Lunch Program, and our agricultural industry;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the week of January 7, 1980 to be

ALL MINNESOTA FOODS WEEK IN ALL MINNESOTA SCHOOLS

and have asked Lieutenant Governor Lou Wangberg to prepare this proclamation for my signature and disseminate the same. I further urge all schools of this State to participate in serving foods procuced and processed in Minnesota.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we have hereunto set our hands and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this nineteenth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred seventy - nine, and of the State the one hundred twenty second.
