



Proclamation

WHEREAS: Ski for Light, Inc., a non-profit Minnesota corporation is sponsoring a series of Skiathons during the week of January 27 through February 3, 1980 in the Twin Cities, St. Cloud, Detroit Lakes, Bemidji, and Red Wing, Madison; and

WHEREAS: Ski for Light is an Official Sons of Norway Outreach; and

WHEREAS: 510 skiers from Norway will join recreational skiers from Minnesota to make this a true international, people-to-people program; and

WHEREAS: These skiers will participate in Ski for Light's 1980 Skiathons under sponsorships in order to raise money for the Vinland National Center, the health sports facility for handicapped people to be built in Minnesota;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the week of January 27 through February 3, 1980 to be
